E.g. Oak (T3) - fell because of excessive shading and low amenity value. Replant with 1 standard ash in the same place.

Felling of dead and dying elm trees (E1.. E5 on sitemap) of which E3 and E4 are close to boundary with residential property and E1/E2 are immediately behind the raised (compost toilet) shed.

Felling of willow tree in middle of boundary with allotment plots - large size causing shadowing of fruit trees/allotments with extensive root system taking moisture from surrounding plants and trees.

Reduce to 2m the 7 of larger trees along boundary with allotment plots: T1/T3/T5/T6/T7 (Hawthorn), T2/T4 (Blackthorn). These were planted at the time of the founding of the orchard (about 15 years ago); this boundary is due to undergo hedge-laying this autumn/winter to reduce its height (and therefore shadowing), to make more of a wind barrier and to provide an improved habitat for wildlife. As such, trees within the hedge line are to be reduced in height to fit in with the hedge and their lower branches integrated within the hedge-laying.

Crown reduce by 30% oak tree T8 near compost bins on lower east side (see map) of orchard to reduce shadowing of nearby fruit trees.
